Mrs Tew-Guthry studied classical ballet for several years both in England and Australia, culminating in two years full time study with Paul Hammond. She worked for some time as a member of the Channel 7 Ballet and then joined J.C. Williamsons touring Australia and Asia in several musicals including My Fair Lady, Promises and Charlie Girl. She has been teaching classical and jazz ballet at

the Beau-Rock Ballet School since 1982 and became Principal in 1992. EXAMINATIONS

The Beau-Rock Ballet School enters students for the Southern Federation of Dance examinations, which are held during the first two weeks of September. All students who reach the required standard are encouraged to sit for examinations as they give the students something to aim for and achieve. They also give parents an external assessment of their child's progress. If you do not wish your child to take part in the exams please let Jenny Guthry know before the end of term two as exams are booked and pre-paid for by the ballet school eight weeks prior to the examination date. Some examinations are held during school time, but most schools are happy to allow students time off as they realize the value to students.

Please remember that competition work requires a great deal of hard work and dedication and we **strongly suggest** that only those students learning classical ballet should enter as it is very difficult to reach the required standard otherwise. Competition Fees are due and payable in Term 2.
